PURPOSE:

To set up an Authorized Official for the ARPA FPG application.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Department is applying for the ARPA Fire Protection Grant. This grant, if we are selected, will be a 50/50 matching grant to be used to purchase a new vehicle. The grant is \$20,000. The Grant requires an Authorized Official to be set up before I can submit the application. Application Due Date is December 5th.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends setting up the Authorized Official as the City Manager.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, STATING INTENT TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN GRANT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND AUTHORIZING DAVID KENNEDY TO SIGN ALL GRANT APPLICATION DOCUMENTS IN AN ATTEMPT TO SECURE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Neosho Fire Department is applying for federal assistance from the American Rescue Plan Grant (ARPA) for the purpose of purchasing a new fire vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

1. David Kennedy, City Manager, is authorized to sign the application for federal assistance and any other official project documents that are necessary to obtain such assistance.
2. This is a \$20,000.00 grant with a 50/50 match.
3. In the event a grant is awarded, the Neosho Fire Department will commit the necessary financial resources.
4. In the event this grant is awarded, the Neosho Fire Department will comply with all rules and regulations of the ARPA FPG, applicable Executive Orders and all state laws that govern the grant application
