NEW BUSINESS

Change Order to the Granger Dirtworks Contract for the Dredging at Lime Kiln Dam

City Manager Kennedy addressed the Council and explained what he was requesting from the Council. When staff first went into the dredging portion of the Lime Kiln Dam project, the city thought we were only going to be able to dredge in and around the immediate area of the intake tube. Since the project began, the dredging has gone very well and benefited the city even more than even projected. The project has gone a lot further with removal than what was originally bid. The bid was for 97 cubic yards of sludge to be dredged from the upper stream. As it stands, we are at 80 loads and both the engineer and the contractor have agreed that to continue with the dredge, removing the remaining portion is in the best interest of the city. Since mobilization of all of the equipment is all paid, they would continue with the project for roughly another 100 loads of sludge which would completely remove the island from the upper portion. This would cost around \$24,000.00 to continue. The original bid was bid in tonnage, so staff is requesting to expand the tonnage of the original contract to allow work to continue.

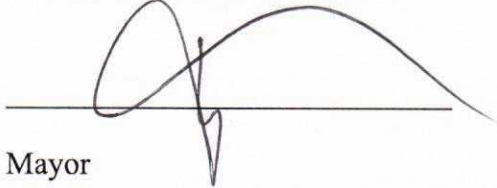

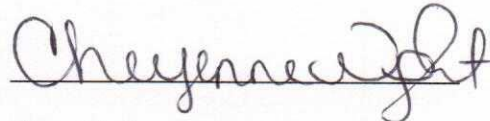
