Bill No. 2023-122: Pool Resurfacing Contract with Envirolitics dba Blast it Clean

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Neosho, Missouri, to enter into an Agreement with Envirolitics, Inc., a Kansas Corporation, d/b/a BLAST IT CLEAN, for the purpose of resealing, prepping, and repainting the Neosho Municipal Pool located at 416 Fairground Rd, Neosho, MO 64850 for the not to exceed price of One Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Four and 55/100 Dollars (\$127,934.55); and authorizing the Mayor to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Neosho.

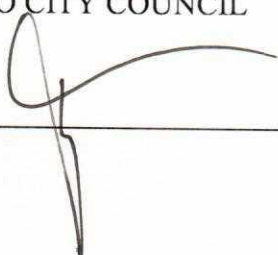

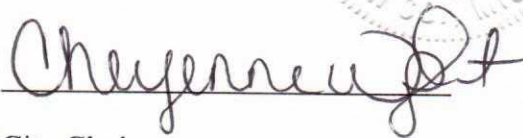
