PURPOSE:

A request for an increase to the speed limit on Baxter Street was made by citizens.

BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Commission met on Monday, October 28, 2024, regarding the request to increase the speed limit on Baxter Street from Summit to Business 49. The request was made to increase the posted speed limit from 25 mph to 30 mph or maybe higher. A discussion by the board was had, and they decided to propose an increase of the posted speed limit to 35 mph since there was no longer semi-traffic using Baxter Street. The board voted in favor of the change. We are requesting the Council's direction on this possible change.
